NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

Notice is hereby given that the [01/2026-27] Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) of the Members of Hilton Metal Forging Limited (the company) will be held on Wednesday the 15th day of July, 2026 at 12:00 p.m. through Video Conference (VC)/Other Audio-Visual Means (OAVM) to transact the following business:

SPECIAL BUSINESS:

Item No. 1:

To create, offer, issue and allot equity shares pursuant to section 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions of Companies Act, 2013 and other applicable laws in one or more tranches, through Qualified Institutions Placement (QIP)

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as a **Special Resolution**:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 42 and 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the rules framed thereunder (including any amendments thereto or re-enactment thereof, for the time being in force, the “Companies Act”), the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, Securities Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“Listing Regulations”) and in accordance with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 (the “SEBI ICDR Regulations”), the provisions of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, (“FEMA”) and rules and regulations framed there under as amended from time to time and subject to other applicable rules, regulations and guidelines issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (“SEBI”), the Reserve Bank of India (“RBI”), the Government of India (“GOI”), the Stock Exchanges and / or any other competent authorities from time to time to the extent applicable, and subject to such required further approvals, permissions, consents and sanctions as may be necessary from SEBI, Stock Exchanges, RBI, GOI and any other authorities as may be required in this regard and further subject to such terms and conditions or modifications as may be prescribed or imposed by any of them while granting any such approvals, permissions, consents and / or sanctions, which may be agreed to by the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as “the Board” which term shall be deemed to include any Committee thereof which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitute to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this Resolution), consent of the members of the company be and is hereby accorded to create, offer, issue and allot such number of equity shares, for an aggregate amount not exceeding ₹100,00,00,000 (Rupees Hundred Crores only) by way of **Qualified Institutional Placement (QIP)** in one or more tranches, through issue of placement document/ or other permissible/requisite offer document to one or more eligible investors, including Qualified Institutional Buyers (“QIBs”) within the meaning prescribed under SEBI ICDR Regulations pursuant to a Qualified Institutional Placement (“QIP”) in accordance with Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations as may be deemed appropriate by the Board at its absolute discretion and in accordance with the relevant provisions of SEBI ICDR Regulations including the discretion to determine the categories of Investors to whom the offer, issue and allotment in tranches or otherwise considering the prevailing market conditions and other relevant factors and wherever necessary in consultation with lead manager(s) and/or underwriter(s) and/or other advisor(s) appointed and / or to be appointed by the Company (the “Issue”).

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in pursuance of the aforesaid resolutions:

(a) the Securities to be so created, offered, issued and allotted shall be subject to the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company; and

(b) the Equity Shares that may be issued by the Company shall rank *Pari passu* with the existing Equity Shares of the Company in all respects.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the allotment of the Eligible Securities, or any combination of Eligible Securities as may be decided by the Board by way of a QIP in terms of Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations (*hereinafter referred to as “Eligible Securities” within the meaning of the SEBI ICDR Regulations*), shall be completed within 365 days from the date of this resolution or such other time as may be allowed under the SEBI ICDR Regulations from time to time.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT issue of Eligible Securities made by way of a QIP in terms of Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations shall be at such price which is not less than the price determined in accordance with the pricing formula provided under Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations (the “QIP Floor Price”). The Company may, however, in accordance with applicable law, also offer a discount of not more than 5% (Five Percentage) or such percentage as permitted under applicable law on the QIP Floor Price.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT for Equity Shares issued to QIBs by way of a QIP in terms of Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, the relevant date for the purpose of pricing of the Equity Shares shall be the date of the meeting in which the Board decides to open the proposed issue of Equity Shares and the relevant date in case of allotment of eligible convertible securities, either the date of the meeting in which the board of directors of the issuer or the committee of directors duly authorised by the board of directors of the issuer decides to open the issue of such convertible securities or the date on which the holders of such convertible securities become entitled to apply for the equity shares.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the issue price shall be subject to appropriate adjustments if the company:

- a) makes an issue of equity shares by way of capitalization of profits or reserves, other than by way of a dividend on shares;
- b) makes a rights issue of equity shares;
- c) consolidates its outstanding equity shares into a smaller number of shares;
- d) divides its outstanding equity shares including by way of stock split;
- e) re-classifies any of its equity shares into other securities of the issuer;
- f) is involved in such other similar events or circumstances, which in the opinion of the concerned stock exchange, requires adjustments.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT for the purpose of giving effect to any offer, issue or allotment of Equity Shares, Securities, or instruments representing the same, as described above, the Board be and is hereby authorized on behalf of the Company to seek listing of any or all of such Securities on the recognised stock exchange where the equity shares of the company are listed.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT such of those equity shares as are not subscribed to may be disposed of by the Board, in its absolute discretion, in such manner, as the Board may deem fit and as permissible under relevant laws/guidelines.

“RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to appoint lead manager(s), underwriters, depositories, custodians, registrars, bankers, lawyers, advisors, monitoring agencies and all such agencies as are or may be required to be appointed, involved or concerned in the Issue and to remunerate them by way of commission, brokerage, fees or the like and also to reimburse them out of pocket expenses incurred by them and also to enter into and execute all such arrangements, agreements, memorandum, documents, etc., with such agencies.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT for the purpose of giving effect to the above, the Board be and is hereby authorized on behalf of the Company to take all actions and do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may, in its absolute discretion, deem necessary, desirable or expedient for the Issue and to resolve and settle all questions, difficulties or doubts that may arise in regard to such Issue in consultation with the merchant banker(s), advisors and/or other intermediaries, as may be appointed in relation to the issue of Securities, including the finalization and approval of the draft as well as final offer document(s), determining the form and manner of the Issue, finalization of the timing of the Issue, identification of the investors to whom the Securities are to be offered, determining the issue price, face value, premium amount on issue/conversion of the Securities, if any, rate of interest, execution of various transaction documents, signing of declarations, creation of mortgage/ charge, utilization of the issue proceeds, without being required to seek any further consent or approval of the members or otherwise to the end and intent that the members shall be deemed to have given their approval thereto expressly by the authority of this resolution.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to delegate all or any of the powers herein conferred to any director(s), KMP(s), committee(s) which may be/have been constituted to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this Resolutions or to any other person in such manner as they may deem fit in their absolute discretion.”

1. The Explanatory Statement according to Section 102 of the Act setting out material facts concerning the business under Item No. 1 of the Notice is annexed hereto.
2. In accordance with the provisions of the Act, read with the Rules made thereunder and General Circular nos. 09/2024 dated 19th September, 2024, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) and Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/P/CIR/2024/133 dated 3rd October, 2024 issued by SEBI (hereinafter collectively referred to as “the Circulars”), the Company will be conducting this Extraordinary General Meeting (“EGM” or “Meeting”) through Video Conferencing/Other Audio Visual Means (“VC”/“OAVM”).
3. Pursuant to the Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this EGM. However, the Body Corporates are entitled to appoint authorized representatives to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM and participate there at and cast their votes through e-voting.
4. The Members can join the EGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the EGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the EGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
5. The attendance of the Members attending the EGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
6. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), and the Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs dated April 08, 2020, April 13, 2020 and May 05, 2020 the Company is providing facility of remote e-Voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the EGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-Voting system as well as venue voting on the date of the EGM will be provided by NSDL.
7. In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the Notice calling the EGM/AGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at <https://hiltonmetal.com/annual-general-meeting/>. The Notice can also be accessed from the websites of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited at www.bseindia.com and www.nseindia.com respectively and the EGM/AGM Notice is also available on the website of NSDL (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility) i.e. www.evoting.nsdl.com.
8. Pursuant to the provisions of the Act, a member entitled to attend and vote at the EGM is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on his/her behalf and the proxy need not be a Member of the Company. Since this EGM is being held pursuant to the MCA Circulars through VC / OAVM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the Members will not be available for the EGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to this Notice.
9. Institutional/Corporate Shareholders (i.e. other than Individuals/HUF, NRI, etc) are required to send a scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of its Board or governing body Resolution/Authorization etc. authorizing its representative to attend the EGM through VC /OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting. The said Resolution/Authorization shall be sent to the Scrutinizer by email through its registered email address to csshreyahshah@gmail.com.
10. The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) vide its Circular No. CIR/MRD/DP/10/2013 dated March 21, 2013 has mandated all Companies to use approved electronic mode of payment for making cash payments such as dividend to the Members (where core banking details are available) or to print the bank account details of the Members (as per the Company's records) on the physical payment.
11. Hence, the Members are requested to furnish/update their bank account name & branch, bank account number and account type along with other core banking details such as MICR (Magnetic Ink Character Recognition), IFSC (Indian Financial System Code) etc. at the earliest with:

In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the Notice calling the EGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.hiltonmetal.com. The Notice

15. 16. The Cut-off date for determining the names of shareholders eligible to get Notice of Extra Ordinary General Meeting is Friday, June 19, 2026.
17. Members who hold shares in physical form in multiple folios in identical names or joint names in the same order of names are requested to send the share certificates to the Company's Registrar & Share Transfer Agent for consolidation into single folio.
18. Since, the securities of the Company are traded compulsorily in dematerialized form as per SEBI mandate, Members holding shares in physical form are requested to get their shares dematerialized at the earliest.
19. As per Regulation 40 of SEBI Listing Regulations, as amended, Securities of listed companies can be transferred only in dematerialized form with effect from, April 1, 2019, except in case of request received for transmission or transposition of securities. In view of this and to eliminate all risks associated with physical shares and for ease of portfolio management, members holding shares in physical form are requested to consider converting their holdings to dematerialized form. 22. The Chairman shall, at the EGM, at the end of discussion on the Resolutions on which the voting is to be held, allow voting with the assistance of the Scrutinizer, by use of e-voting for all those Members who are present at the EGM through VC/AOVM.
23. The scrutinizer shall after the conclusion of voting at the Meeting, will first count the votes cast at the Meeting in the presence of at least two witnesses not in the employment of the Company and shall make and submit, within 48 hours of the conclusion of the EGM, a consolidated scrutinizer's Report of the total votes cast in favour or against, if any, to the Chairman or a person authorized by him in writing, who shall countersign the same and declare the result of the voting within 48 hours of conclusion of the EGM.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

Item No. 1: To create, offer, issue and allot equity shares pursuant to section 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions of Companies Act, 2013 and other applicable laws in one or more tranches, through Qualified Institutions Placement (QIP)

Your Company diligently pursues avenues for business growth, it is imperative to ensure the availability and allocation of sufficient resources, including funds. While internal fund generation remains a crucial aspect, it may not always suffice to meet the entirety of the Company's ambitious growth plans. Prudence dictates the need for a structured approach to funding, which can be achieved through the issuance of Securities as defined in the resolution. It is therefore proposed that the Company secures the requisite enabling approvals to bolster its long-term resources and maintain adequate liquidity to address various funding requirements. These requirements encompass business activities, existing and new projects, future business growth initiatives, capital expenditure, long-term working capital needs, as well as refinancing, repayment, or pre-payment obligations of the Company and/or its subsidiaries. This will enable the Company to swiftly capitalize on emerging opportunities as they arise.

Your approval will enable the Board to create, issue, offer and allot Equity Shares by way of Qualified Institutional Placement in accordance with Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, in one or more tranches, at such price as may be deemed appropriate by the Board in accordance with Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations including the discretion to determine the categories of Investors to whom the issue, offer, and allotment shall be made considering the prevalent market conditions and other relevant factors and wherever necessary, in consultation with lead manager(s) and other agencies that may be appointed by the Board for the purpose of the Issue.

This special resolution will enable the Board to issue by way of Qualified Institutional Placement (QIP) in one or more tranches. As the Issue may result in the issue of Equity Shares of the Company to investors who may or may not be members of the Company, consent of the members is being sought pursuant to Section 62(1) (c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 and any other law for the time being in force and being applicable and in terms of the provisions of the Securities Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.

The details for deployment of funds will be specifically mentioned in the preliminary placement document/ placement document or other requisite offer document in terms of applicable circulars of BSE and NSE, in this regard.

Certain terms of the proposed QIP, in the manner as set out in the resolution vide agenda item no 1 of this Notice, would be as under:

- (i) the allotment of Securities shall only be made to qualified institutional buyers ("QIBs") as defined under SEBI ICDR Regulations;
- (ii) the allotment of the Securities shall be completed within 365 days from the date of passing of the special resolution in accordance with the SEBI ICDR Regulations and applicable laws;
- (iii) a minimum of 10% of the Securities shall be allotted to mutual funds and if mutual funds do not subscribe to the aforesaid minimum percentage or part thereof, such minimum portion may be allotted to other QIBs;

- (vi) an issuer shall be eligible to make a qualified institutions placement if any of its promoters or directors is not a fugitive economic offender;
- (vii) no single allottee shall be allotted more than 50% of the QIP size and the minimum number of allottees shall be in accordance with the SEBI ICDR Regulations. It is clarified that qualified institutional buyers belonging to the same group or who are under same control shall be deemed to be a single allottee;
- (viii) the Securities to be offered and allotted shall be in dematerialized form and shall be allotted on fully paid up basis;
- (ix) the Securities allotted shall not be eligible for sale by the allottee for a period of one year from the date of allotment, except on a recognized stock exchange, or except as may be permitted from time to time;

(x) the schedule of the QIP will be as determined by the Board or its duly authorized committee; and

(xi) The Company shall not undertake any subsequent QIP until the expiry of two weeks from the date of the QIP to be undertaken pursuant to the special resolution passed at this meeting. In the event of a QIP pricing of the Equity Shares that may be issued to QIBs shall be freely determined subject to such price not being less than floor price calculated in accordance with Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, provided that the Company may offer a discount not exceeding 5% of the floor price or such other permissible limit as may be specified under the SEBI ICDR Regulations.

(xii) the appointment of credit rating agency is not applicable as the Issue size is not exceeding Rs. 100 Crores (Rupees One Hundred Crores)

Please note, the Members of the Company had earlier accorded their approval by way of a Special Resolution passed at the Extra-Ordinary General Meeting held on April 21, 2025, authorizing the Company to raise funds through a Qualified Institutions Placement ("QIP") in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended ("SEBI ICDR Regulations").

However, owing to prevailing market conditions and other commercial considerations, the Company could not complete the proposed QIP within the validity period prescribed under the SEBI ICDR Regulations. In terms of Regulation 172 of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, a special resolution approving a QIP remains valid for a period of 365 days from the date of passing of the resolution. Consequently, the aforesaid shareholders' approval has lapsed and is no longer valid for undertaking a QIP.

In view of the above and considering the Company's present and future funding requirements, the Board of Directors proposes to obtain a fresh enabling approval from the Members to raise funds aggregating up to ₹100 Crores through one or more Qualified Institutions Placements, in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the SEBI ICDR Regulations.

The proposed resolution is an enabling resolution and authorizes the Board to undertake the fund-raising exercise at an appropriate time, subject to market conditions and other relevant considerations.

The Board of Directors of the company recommends passing of the resolution as set out at item no 1 of this Notice for the approval of the members as special resolution. None of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel of the Company or their relatives is, whether directly or indirectly, concerned or interested, financial or otherwise, in the passing of the aforesaid resolution except to the extent of their shareholding, if any, in the Company.
